Free Catalytic Converter Theft Prevention Etching Event

WHEN: Saturday, July 29, 2023 from 9:00am to 1:00pm

WHERE: RPV City Hall – 30940 Hawthorne Blvd.

The theft of catalytic converters has grown considerably nationwide and become a hot commodity for thieves because of their value, relative ease to steal (unbolt or cut out), and lack of identifying markings. The lack of identification makes it hard to identify victims and successfully apprehend and prosecute criminals. Thieves take stolen catalytic converters to metal recyclers who will pay up to \$250 per converter for the precious metals inside them. Victims, however, will pay an average of \$1000 (or their deductible) to replace it.

As a result, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will hold an etching event for the residents of Rolling Hills, Rolling Hills Estates and Rancho Palos Verdes on Saturday, July 29, 2023 from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

You can take advantage of the lawn-to-garden rebate that offers \$3 per square foot for removing turf and replacing it with water-wise landscaping. A minimum of 250 square feet must be removed, and the project must be pre-approved.

**Pool Safety Tips: How to Keep your Family Safe by The
American Red Cross**



Owning a pool, hot tub, or other water feature comes with responsibilities. Follow these easy guidelines to make sure you and your family have a safe and splashing summer. Understand the risks:

Home pool drowning is a leading cause of death for children younger than five years of age. Children who drown are often out of sight for less than five minutes and under the care of one or both parents at the time of many home pool drownings.

To Prevent Drowning

- Secure your pool or hot tub with barriers such as:
 - A fence around the entire pool that is at least 5 feet tall with a self-latching or self-closing gate.
 - Mount a lockable structural barrier that fully encloses the top of a hot tub and will not collapse under the weight of a child –
- Secure your pool or hot tub with barriers such as installing a safety cover and alarm on doors.
- Remove any pool toys from the pool or hot tub area when the area is not in use.
- Establish and enforce rules, such as no one swims alone, stay away from drains, no loose/dangling items, and no diving.

Maintain Constant Supervision

- Maintain constant supervision of children whenever around water.
- Avoid distractions when supervising children around water.
- Have children or inexperienced swimmers wear approved life jackets or flotation devices.
- Block access to unguarded, non-designed swimming areas.
- Do not use alcohol and/or drugs before or while using a pool or hot tub. Alcohol impairs judgement, balance, coordination; affects swimming and diving skills; and reduces the body's ability to stay warm.

Safety Equipment to Have Accessible

- First aid kit.
- Emergency signal, such as a whistle.
- Multiple life jackets in various sizes.
- Reaching device.
- Throwing device.

Know How to Respond to an Emergency

- If a child is missing, check the water first. Seconds count in preventing death or disability.
- Know how and when to call 9-1-1 or the local emergency number.

· Learn how to safely respond to aquatic and other emergencies by taking Red Cross Courses, such as, First Aid, CPR, Lifeguarding and Basic Water Rescue.
