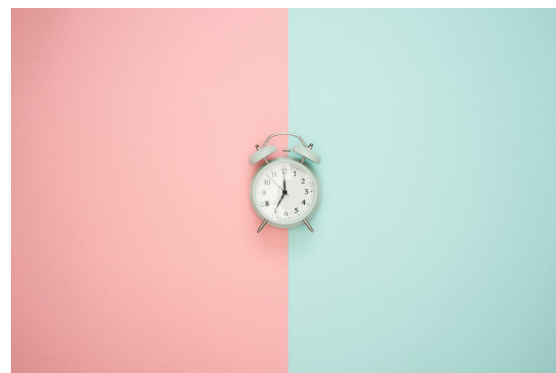

WHAT IS ALERT SOUTHBAY?

The Alert SouthBay, emergency notification system aims to keep communities informed about disasters and major emergencies via SMS (text), email, phone, landline, as well as other means of communication.

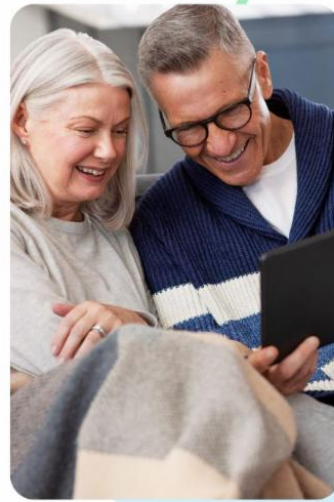

RHCA Green Waste Chipping

RHCA GREEN WASTE CHIPPING

Starting November 14, 2022

To assist owners in fire fuel management on their properties, the Rolling Hills Community Association has scheduled a city-wide chipping program! This allows residents the opportunity to thin out vegetation and create defensible space on their property by clearing brush from their easements and the 30'-100' around buildings as recommend by the Fire Department.

See **READY SET GO** for fire clearance guidelines.

Please follow these directions to participate in this free program:

Do's ✓	Don'ts ✗
All vegetation <i>must</i> be at the street by 7AM November 14th Cut ends must face same direction, towards street Piles must be on the road shoulder, piles on private property will not be chipped Piles must be free of rocks, dirt and any wire Recently cut vegetation chips better than old, decayed vegetation Tell the chipping companies if you would like to keep the chips for your property or they will be hauled away	Don't place vegetation out before November 9th <u>*THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP*</u> No branches larger than 10" in diameter No Root Balls No Palm Fronds or Spiny Plants No Leaf Piles No Succulents or Yucca No Poison Oak No Construction Debris (Lumber/Fencing)

*If vegetation is **not placed** by the roadside by 7AM Monday November 14th, it will **not be eligible** for chipping.*

It is the homeowner's responsibility to dispose of any items left on the roadside.

The Rolling Hills Community Association has scheduled a city-wide chipping program November 14th. Trim on your property, put the green waste at the curb & the RHCA will chip it for free, no cactus! This allows residents to get rid of unwanted brush/ plants and to fire proof their property. For the full article click the link below.
